l	l	ל	<p>Judeo-Esperanto is largely based on Yiddish orthography with some Ladino influence. The main distinction from YIVO Yiddish is a lack of multi-letter consonant digraphs, in order to better reflect the Esperanto maxim of “<i>unu litero - unu sono</i>.” Ladino influence is seen in its use of <i>varika</i> as a diacritic parallel to the Esperanto circumflex, as well as certain consonant-usage choices. Vowels largely follow YIVO Yiddish, albeit with a few additional signs for diphthongs not found in YIVO.</p>			ej	ej̣	ײַ
